## **Buses - mixed news to date**

THE current news on bus services to West Hunsbury is mixed.

As predicted in the last FOCUS leaflet, the number 12A evening service to Camp Hill has been cut because of the cuts to bus subsidies.

Transport officer John Ellerby has commented that



although this service has been lost, the number 88 service from the bus Towcester Road does provide some level of evening service,

though Morrisons staff have to walk to Toys R Us to catch it.

At a recent bus consultation meeting I again made the point that people in West Hunsbury really needed the number 28 service or something similar, even at a reduced frequency. I was assured that the county council was listening.

The future of the 28 bus remains uncertain. The number 42 bus is covering Hunsbury Hill Road and station via the Hunslet Lane, but the frequency is changing from two per hour to hourly.

> If the 28 is lost it will make it hard to access Delapre surgery, Morrisons or The Drapery.
